

<b>Aim:</b>			
Assess the use of bins in waste disposal			
<b>Change idea:</b>			
Improve the use of the appropriate bin for waste disposal			
<b>What questions do you want answered for this test of change?</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Is the appropriate bin being used for disposing of non-clinical and clinical waste?</li> <li>2. Is waste disposal in line with infection control guidance on bin use?</li> </ol>			
<b>List the tasks needed to set up this test of change:</b>	Person responsible	Date to be completed	Where to be done
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Assess if bins are being appropriately used in the clinical area (e.g. look at bin contents and assess if waste is in correct bin)</li> <li>2. Ask team about what bin they are using for different forms of waste (e.g. create a survey and distribute about bin use).</li> <li>3. Deliver teaching session on which waste disposal bin to use, in accordance with Infection Control guidance Create posters/resources to promote appropriate bin use.</li> </ol>			
<b>Describe the measured results:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Number of items in correct/incorrect clinical and non-clinical waste bin:</li> <li>2. Is bin waste disposal being used appropriately (survey results):</li> </ol>			
<b>Complete a further QI cycle to assess the impact of this test of change:</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Calculate the number correct/incorrect waste disposal items in bins being used after the teaching session/poster</li> <li>2. Repeat the survey asking about bin use after the teaching session</li> </ol>
